

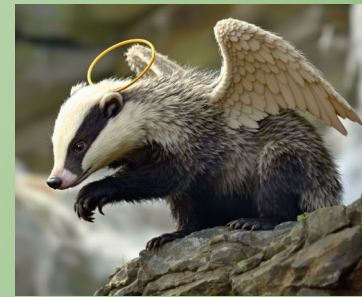
Friday 3rd October

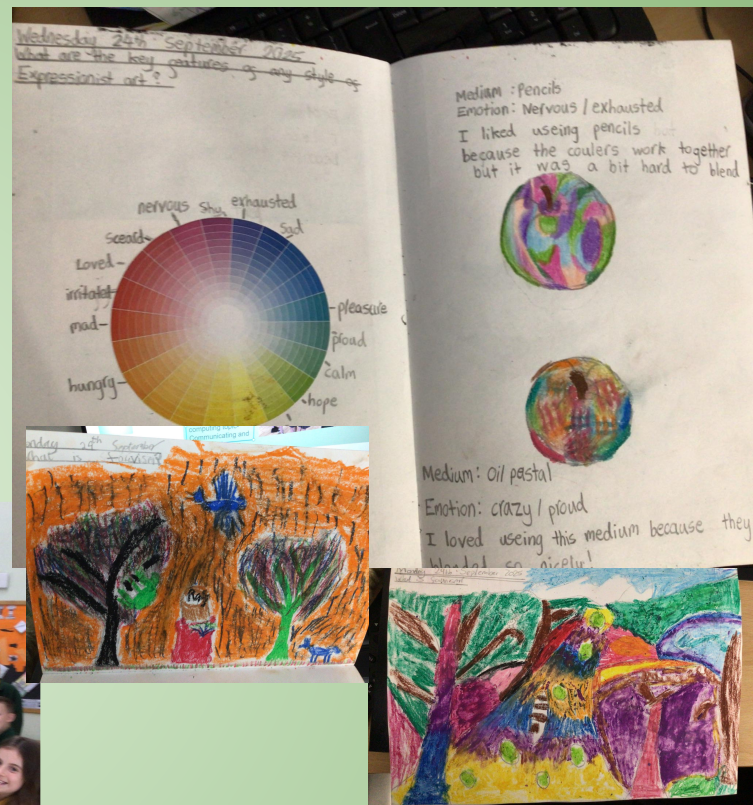
