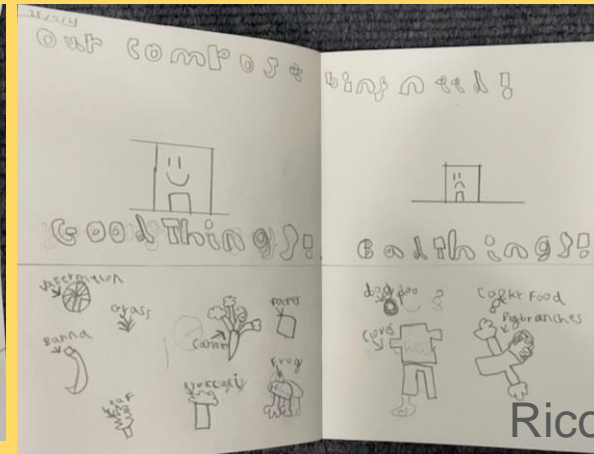

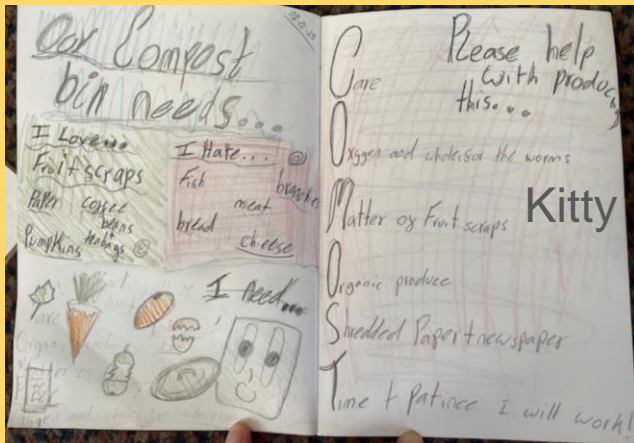

Collecting leaves to make compost.

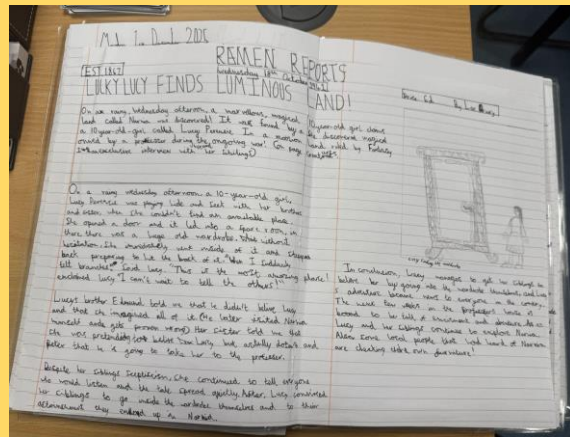
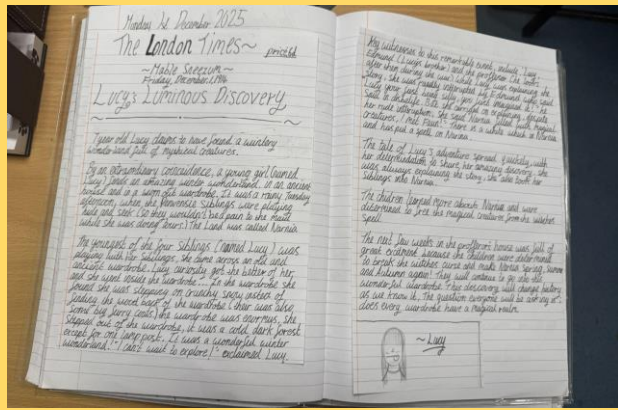


Some really fantastic posters from the owls on what goes in the compost bin. Special mention to Kitty, Sydney and Mable for going above and beyond what was asked of them!
