Personality: Edmund is a young boy. With brown hair, grey eyes, he also has dimples in his cheeks. He is not shy.

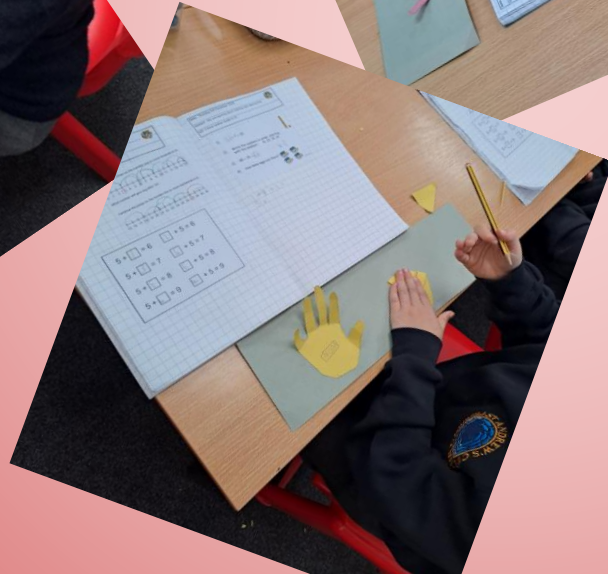
