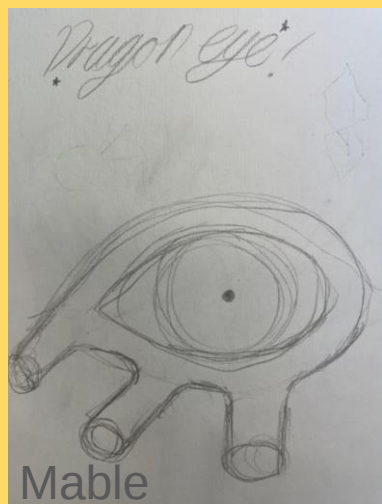
Owls visited Ickworth House



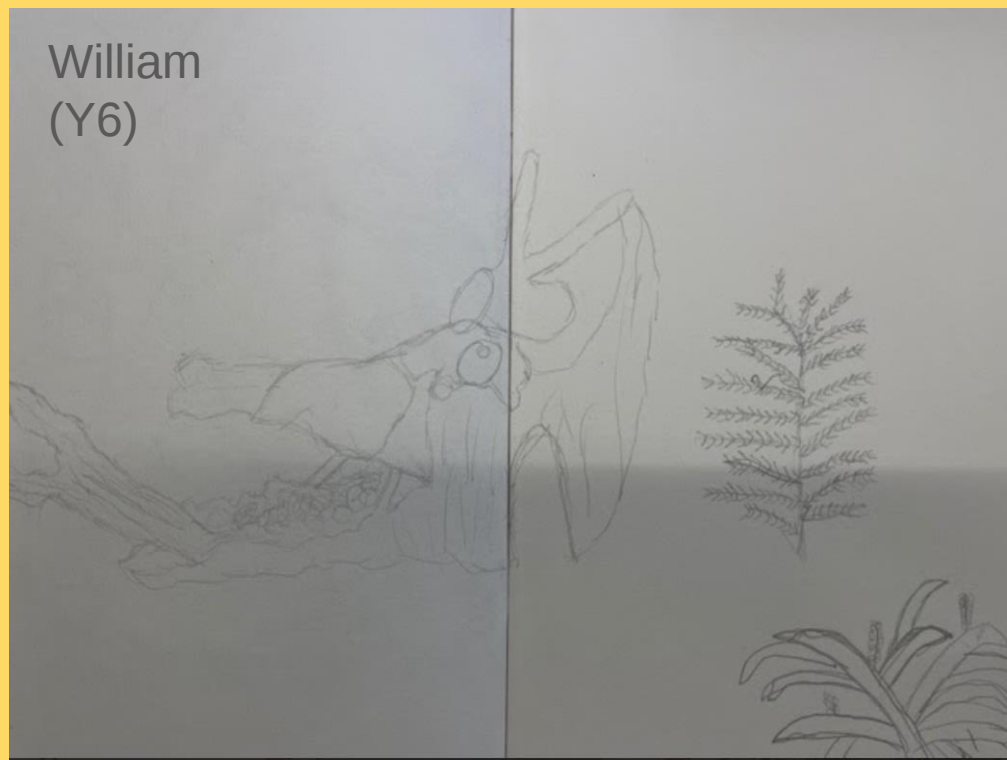
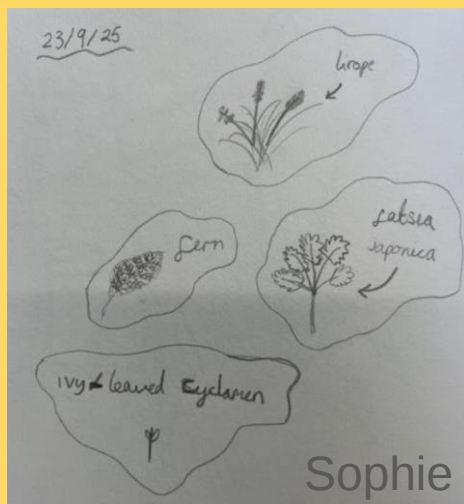


Owls found the stump dragon, plants and flowers for 'the bank' project

Owls took their science learning outside this week. They conducted an experiment on the effects of exercise on our heart rate. They had fun thinking of different exercises to try!





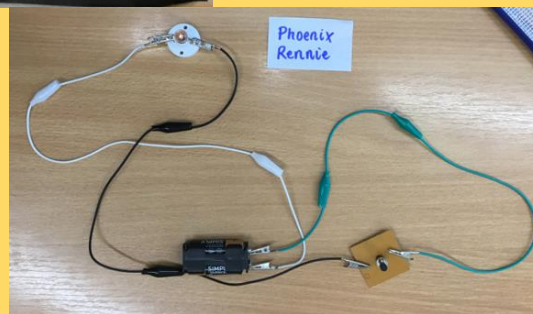
Following Mrs Nichols' assembly on Monday, Foxes created their own artwork to show love for the world.
