Fox Class enjoyed a wonderful afternoon at Forest school on Tuesday. What a fantastic way to begin the year!



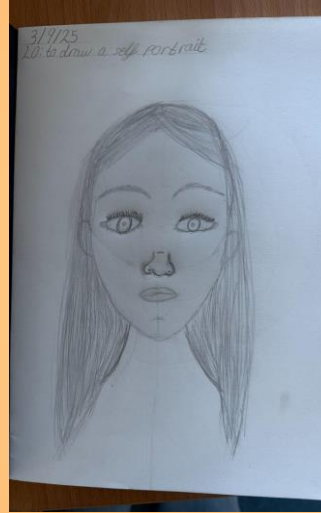
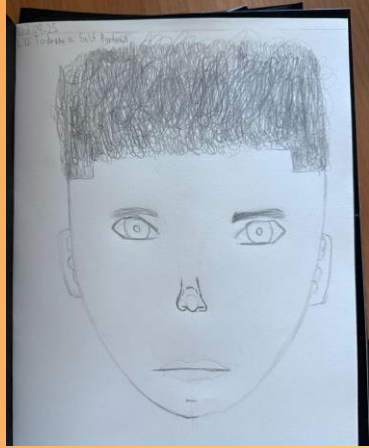
Foxes created inner-self portraits which celebrated their individuality.

They worked so hard and we were so impressed with how they turned out.



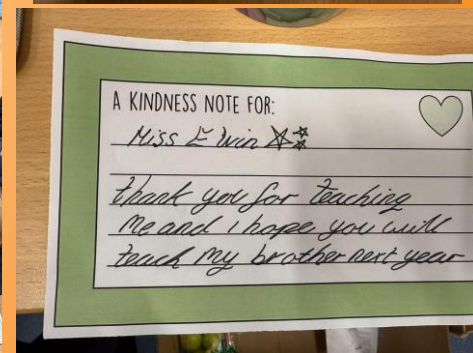
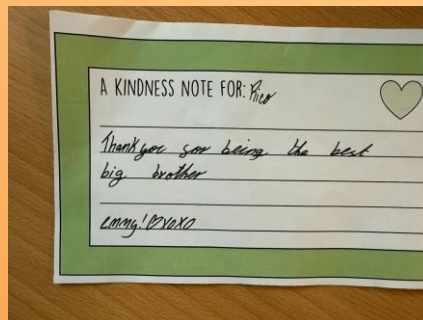
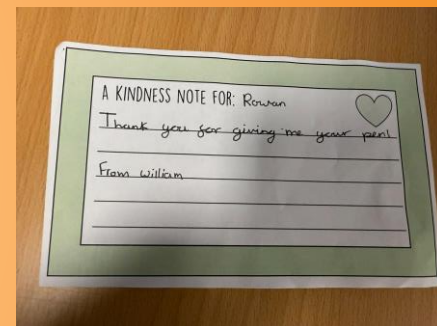
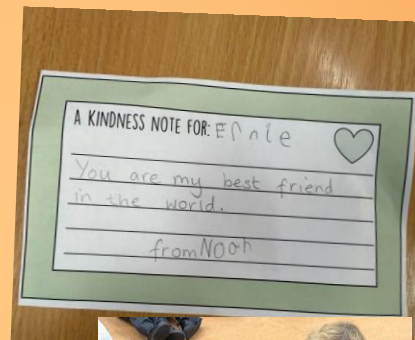
