Dear Parents/Carers,

This term, Otter class will be venturing into Bakers Wood for their Forest School sessions. These sessions start from <u>Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September</u>, and will run weekly each Friday.

Forest School is a fantastic outdoor learning experience where children learn naturally about the world around them, how to use tools safely, cook on campfires, and develop their physical, social, and emotional skills.

Your child will need to arrive at school on Forest School days wearing suitable Forest School clothing:

- Waterproof jacket \*

- Full length trousers
- Jumper
- Coat (only when it's cold- The coat should be worn underneath a waterproof jacket to provide warmth)
- Hat, Scarf and Gloves (only when it's cold)

Your child will need to bring their school uniform, including shoes, to get changed into after their Forest School Session and a <u>bag</u> to put their dirty forest school clothes into.
