We compared Kensuke's Kingdom the book, and Kensuke's Kingdom the movie. We all agreed the book was much better!

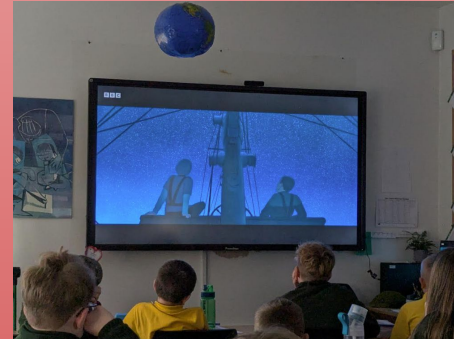
We were inspired by cubist art to paint the sort of icebergs Captain Scott saw on his expedition to Antarctica.



Josh brought in his snow goggles.

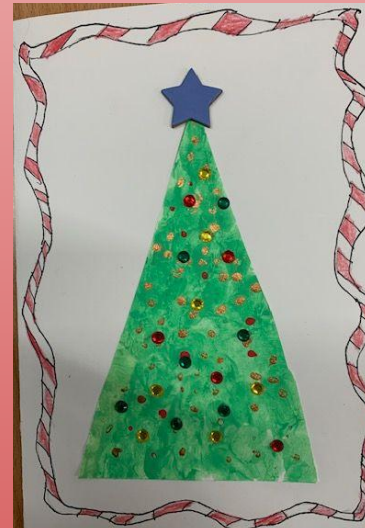


We hope you like Our Christmas cards. Merry Christmas everyone!

To finish our Maths learning about shapes, Badgers spent time yesterday making Gingerbread Houses!



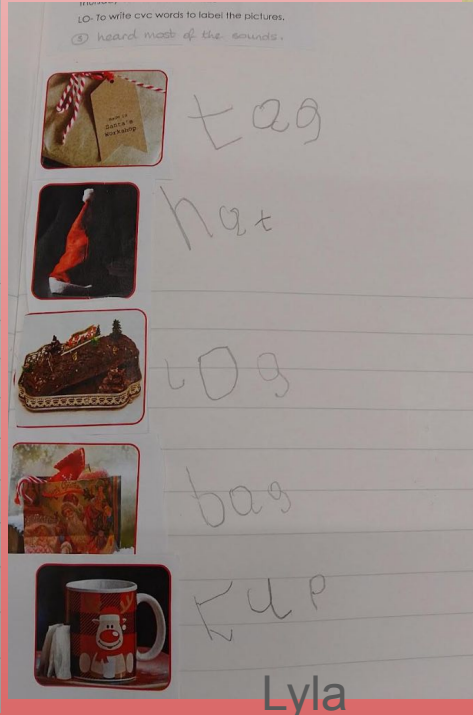
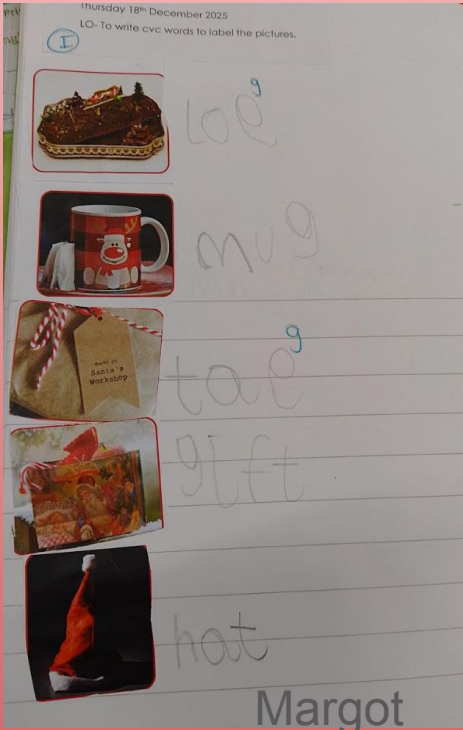
This week Hedgehogs have been writing labels for Christmas items and using our set 1 single sounds.

Hedgehogs finished writing in their Christmas cards this week and wrapped their salt dough gifts and have taken these home for their families.



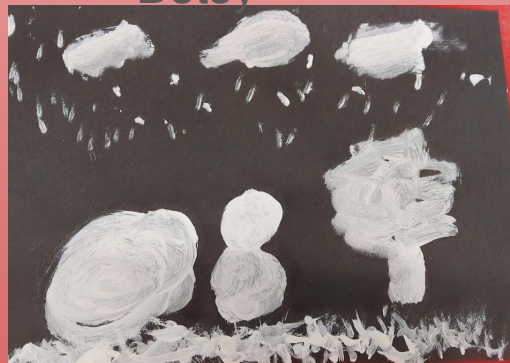


We had a very enjoyable art session this week. Children used white paint on a black background to create a snowy winter scene.

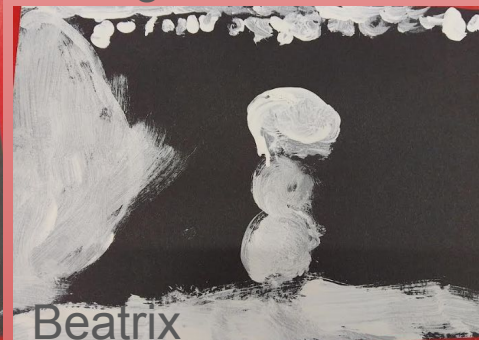
