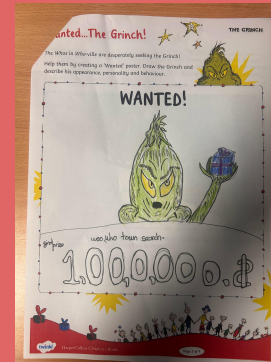
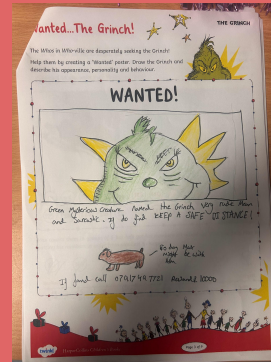
MERRY CHRISTMAS

Well done to the brave Swifts and Kites who tried the pickled beetroot, it was a real hit with some and they loved how it turned their tongues pink!

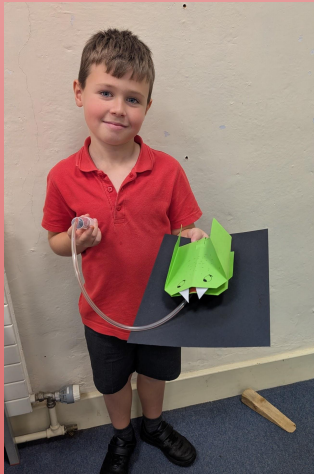
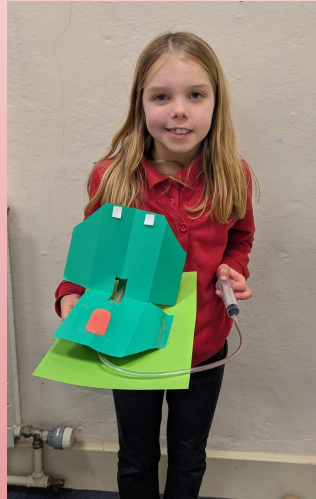
Great work decorating our narcissus (daffodil) filled plant pots to give as gifts to our family or friends. Lovely designs.
