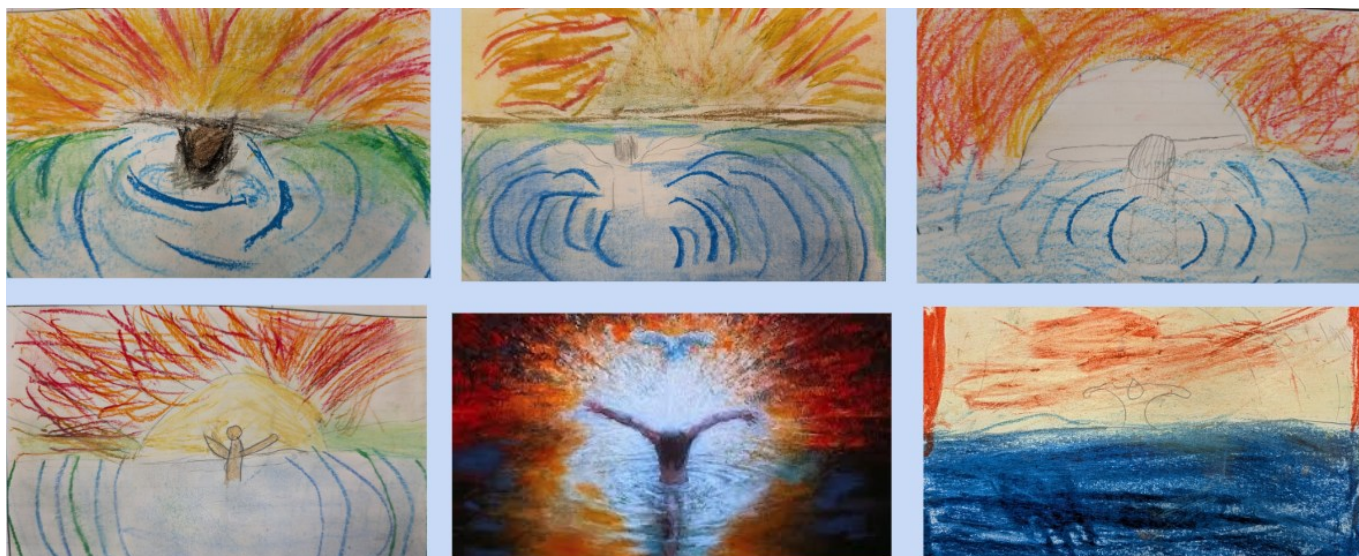

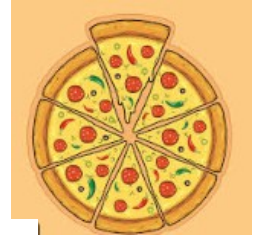
Henry in Wren Class for his amazing focus and progress in phonics.
