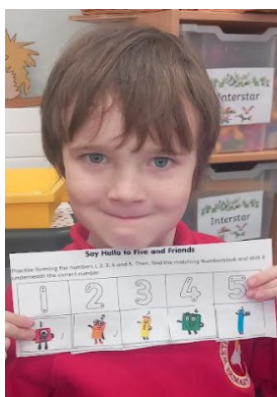

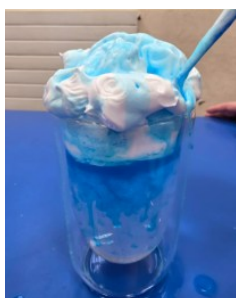
This week
